

# Pathways to Future Opportunity

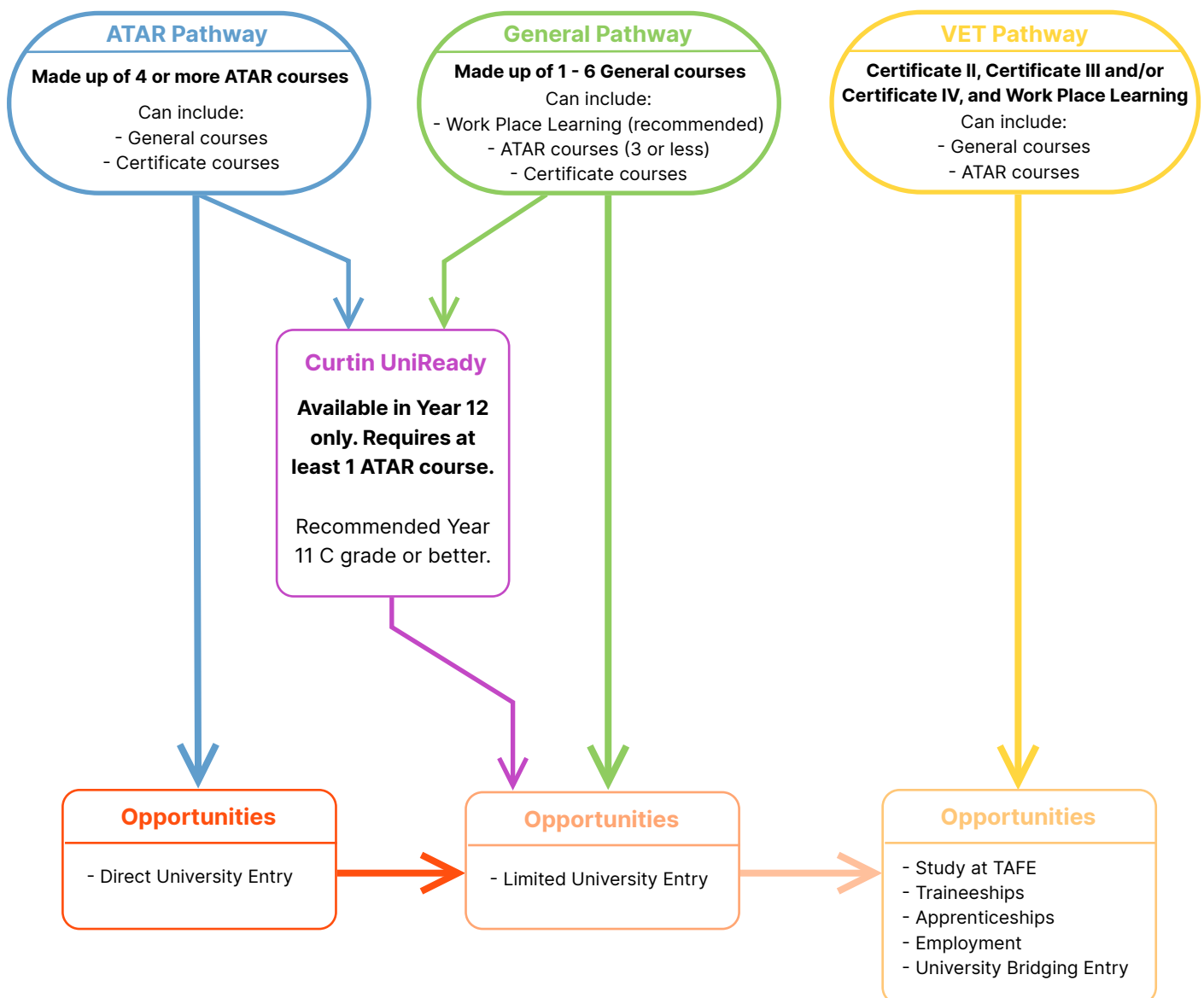


This guide will assist you to make choices for Years 11 and 12 study, and towards post-secondary options. You may be interested in university study, have a specific career in mind that will involve further education and training, or intend to enter the workforce after leaving school.

## Year 11 Course Load

In Year 11, students must enrol in 6 courses (includes Certificate qualifications)

Students can enrol in a combination of ATAR courses, General courses, VET Certificate courses or endorsed programs. This allows students to build a personalised curriculum aligned with their interests and career ambitions, and to achieve their Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE).



Some ATAR courses will recommend prerequisite-achievement in Year 10, to ensure students are prepared for the learning, and are likely to achieve success, in Year 11. Where students have not met recommended prerequisite-achievement in Year 10, for a particular course in Year 11, they must discuss their enrolment in the course with the relevant Head of Learning Area (HOLA).
